

Services: The University shall provide the following Services to the Client:

Expert advice in connection with a Coastal Hazard Assessment, and a study that will allow the identification of areas of coastal hazards on the Kapiti CDC coastline in terms of Policy 24 of the NZCPS, and, without limitation, specifically

- giving priority to the identification of areas at high risk of being affected
- and assessing the hazard risk over at least 100 years in terms of the subparas of Policy 24
- taking account of national guidance and the best available info on the likely effects of climate change
- to provide as far as possible a probabilistic analysis to allow the application of Policies 25 and 27 of the NZCPS and to support the use of Policy 3. This raises the different types of uncertainties we are dealing with, and they need to be reported separately.
- to be available to support a subsequent piece of work using the results to translate Policies 25, 27 & 3 into appropriate actions by KCDC.
