Afternoon Salima,

Attached with his please note the advice to councillors in response to your email.

While I can appreciate your wish to keep councillors informed on this very important matter I'm sure you will appreciate that we have set up a process through the Coastal Assessment Panel which will receive and progress a whole range of complex technical data and community views. It's important for this formal process to function and for your group to put your own input and participation into this formal process. Councillors, as governance, need to now allow that process to work. It would not be helpful for councillors to create another parallel, and political, duplicate process which is open to the same submitters (like CRU) to the CAP to also submit to councillors.

CAP will at the end of their deliberations make a formal report and recommendations to council. I think it's at that point that CRU or any other submitters to the CAP process should present their views to full council. This would help councillors keep an open mind and consider all the views and issues before making the type of decisions that will inform any changes to the Operative District Plan. I believe any changes to the DP will have to also go through a submission process. In conclusion I'm confident the process before us allows for robust opportunities for engagement.

This is the staff response in regards to the email all Councillors received on 27 July 2021 from Salima Padamsey.

I understand Jacobs are currently reviewing the CRU report and we have provided CRU with a response setting out the review process. This will involve a meeting with the relevant experts to discuss the CRU report findings and staff. At the moment we don't have a date for that meeting as Jacobs need to confirm when they will complete their review. Once we have a date we will confirm that with CRU directly.

The Takutai Kāpiti project ([Takutai Kāpiti project: Our Journey – Takutai Kāpiti \(takutaikapiti.nz\)](https://www.takutaikapiti.nz)) is the agreed process for advancing the Coastal Hazard discussions with our community and CRU. The Coastal Assessment Panel (CAP) will be provided with all the relevant technical information they need to help them make their recommendations back to Council, this will include the review undertaken by CRU and I am sure, if the CAP want to meet with CRU or have them present this information to them then that's what would happen.

This is the process signed off by Council at 10 December 2020 meeting.
