I would like to take this opportunity to provide you with a technical review that CRU has undertaken in regard to coastal hazards.

First, on 7 July, KCDC received CRU's technical review of Jacobs' Volume 1.

Council staff is aware of the fact that this review was prepared by our Coastal Science Team. I have attached a copy for your records.

We would welcome the opportunity to present this review to Council, similar to the opportunity afforded to Jacobs on 27 May 2021. It is vital that our elected representatives understand the key issues that the review raises, as this affects hundreds of families, all of whom are members of CRU.

As with the Jacobs' presentation, our team would also be willing to meet in a briefing/workshop format enabling Councillors to ask/comment/discuss the review off the record.

It may also interest you to know that we have requested a similar meeting with Sean Mallon, Lyndsey Craig and the Coastal Team on 3 separate occasions - 7th July, 13th July and 19 July. To date, we have had no response.

I look forward to our joint co-operation.
