Thanks for your patience with my response – I also thought it was a very constructive meeting, and it was good to be able to provide an overview of the intent, how we could work together, and inherent challenges that we believe the RMA requirements impose (per our previous email exchanges).

I just checked in with the Mayor and Councillors yesterday to confirm our proposed pathway forward. At the meeting on 10 August, you received the 'green light' for furthering the discussion for all Councillors and the Mayor. The Mayor had asked that we set up an additional meeting to work through the follow up queries that the Councillors may have. <u>@Emily Humble</u> will be in touch to identify a date and time that can work for this, but in short, I agreed with the Mayor and Councillors that this should be within the next month. Appreciate that Quentin is available for questions on core content, however, Councillors and the Mayor have expressed a preference to be able to have a group session so that they can hear the same information and discussion together. Hopefully that can work at your end. Am I right in assuming you and Quentin would attend this meeting?

The MOU next steps would fall out of the next meeting that we have. Councillors did mention to me that as they had also made a decision on PC2 on the same day, some of them were slightly distracted by what was a major decision to work through, and they wanted to give the proposal for a private plan change appropriate consideration without any side distractions. I think that is positive.

On another note, <u>@Emily Humble</u> is looking for a time for you and I to catch up ... the last week has been slightly hectic post the PC2 decision.
